Ed's Report:

--Eric Langevin requested \$50 each for 8-9 athletes to go to indoor New Englands.

--Ed requested funding for 4 boys and 4 girls to attend the Student Athlete Leadership Conference. \$100 per student-athlete

--We can set up a 50-50 table at the entrance to the state gymnastics meet instead of trying to sell inside during the meet.

--We made \$1800 profit on sales of \$3,000 at the NVAC cheerleading competition. It was too much to do two concession stands. In the future we could offer the second "healthy choice" snacks to another group to run.

--Programs have not sold well. One full box, plus left. Do we want to sell them for less or give them away.

--What to do about a spring program. Yearbook could combine it with their spring sports supplement. They would need 900 to go out with the yearbook. Distribution would resemble fall with not very many gated/paying events. Could use coaches to have their players sell one or two each. What happened to advertising \$\$ for winter program? Who paid the printing bill? April 9—spring team pictures taken, April 11--first boys lacrosse game.

--For concession planning, the spring sports schedules are on the website. There are also middle school track meets on April 16, May 12, May 16, and May 21.

--The winter sports playoffs have begun and the schedule is very busy.

--Boys and girls basketball teams will work the Hershey Track Meet in July. Track teams are a back-up.

--Spring coaches meeting is March 5<sup>th</sup> from 2:45-4:00. Spring sports sign-ups are March 6<sup>th</sup>. The Meet the Coaches Night is not yet set. It should be early April.
